ROLES

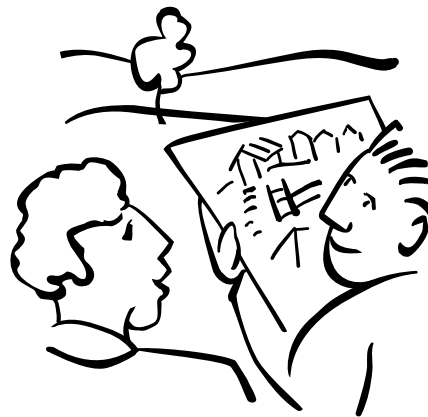
Family
